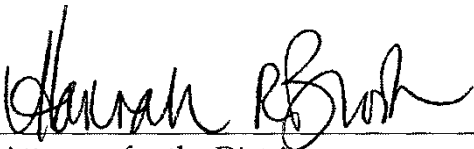
BRAZORIA COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 36

1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes.
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, and review of investments.
4. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
5. Approve Annual Report and authorize filing of same in accordance with the District's Continuing Disclosure of Information Agreement and as required by SEC Rule 15c2 12.
6. Annual Review of Procedures for Continuing Disclosure Compliance.
7. Historical bond and tax report to Comptroller.
8. Discuss amendment to Professional Services Agreement with Blackline Engineering, LLC and authorize appropriate action.
9. Engineering matters, including preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, Pay Estimates and Change Orders, acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company of new facility, if appropriate, including:
 - a. Kendall Lakes Section 12 Clearing and Grubbing;
 - b. Kendall Lakes Section 12; and
 - c. Kendall Lakes Section 12 Detention.
10. Authorize acceptance and/or conveyance of deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, abandonment of easements, and utility conveyance and security agreements.
11. Report on maintenance of District facilities, including lake improvements, review proposals, and authorize appropriate action.
12. Update on alligator removal and relocation.
13. Storm water management plan and storm water permitting matters, receive public comment, training, and authorize appropriate action.
14. Discuss security matters, including quarterly security report from Flock Safety.

15. District website matters, including discuss changes and updates to website.
16. Discuss future park projects, including preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, Pay Estimates and Change Orders, and acceptance of projects, including:
 - a. Trail and Lighting Improvements.
17. Report regarding development in the District, including financing agreements and assignments of financing agreements.
